

Equine health camp and interactive meet of equine owners organized at Singhana (Jind)

ICAR-National Research Center on Equines organized equine health camp and interactive meet of equine owners at the village Singhana in Safedo Tehsil, Jind on August 31, 2015. During the equine health camp, 20 equines were examined for various ailments by a multidisciplinary team of scientists and technical officer from the centre. Veterinary officer and staff at Veterinary Hospital Singhana assisted the NRCE team in organization of the equine health camp. Deworming tablets were provided to equine owners free of cost and emergency treatment was given on the spot to three wounded equines. The bio-samples were also collected from the 17 animals for disease epidemiological studies.

The NRCE team responded to various queries and answered questions of equine owners on health and management of equines. Information was given on deworming schedule, prevention and management of ticks, colic and lameness in equines. The equine owners were also briefed about management, housing, hoof care, timely shoeing and grooming of animals.
