

## **Equine Health Camp and Interactive Equine Owners Meet organized at Kachhla in Badaun district in Uttar Pradesh**

ICAR-National Research Center on Equines organized equine health camp and interactive equine owners meet at Kachhla in Badaun district in Uttar Pradesh on September 09, 2015. Veterinary officer from veterinary hospital Uzhani Badaun district and Brooke India officials were also present on the occasion. During the health camp, 47 equines were examined for various ailments by a multidisciplinary team of scientists and technical officer from the centre. Deworming tablets, mineral mixture and antiseptic lotion were provided to equine owners free of cost. On the spot emergency treatment was given to two sick and wounded equines. The bio-samples were also collected from the animals for disease epidemiological studies. Equine owners interacted with multidisciplinary team of scientists from NRCE on various aspects of equine husbandry, breeding and management. At Kachhla, Nurpur and Kadar chowk area in Badaun district equines are kept by people of Qalandar community on Ganga river basin for breeding purpose. Information about deworming schedule, prevention and management of diseases in equines was given to equine owners. The toll-free helpline number of NRCE was provided to equine owners for assistance.
